



Dylon Pre-Dye Instructions

DYLON Pre-Dye is designed to remove colour from fabric so that it can be dyed to a lighter colour. It lightens fabric to a neutral shade, creating a 'blank canvas' that you can dye to any colour.

Use when you want to change one strong colour to another (e.g. from brown to Tulip Red), or to dye fabric to a lighter shade (e.g. brown to Pebble Beige).

DIRECTIONS

1. Weigh dry items to ensure that they are 2.5kg or less. If you need to treat more than 2.5kg of fabric, do so with two or more machine loads.
2. Put fabric in the washing machine. Set and start the longest/hottest programme (85°C/95°C).
3. After about 15 minutes dissolve pack contents in 2 litres of hot water and add to machine via detergent drawer.
4. When cycle is complete, add usual washing detergent, wash fabric as usual and then dye to the colour of your choice using Dylon Machine Dye.

HELPFUL HINTS

- One box treats up to a maximum of 2.5kg of fabric (e.g. double duvet cover, sheet and pillows).
- Pre-Dye may not return fabric to white
- Always use the full contents of the pack
- Some colours may not be removed, e.g. bright greens, bright blues, & indigo (denim)
- For use in front loading automatic machines only - NOT suitable for twin-tub, top loading or launderette machines.

IMPORTANT

- Always use in a well-ventilated room.
- Do not breathe fumes especially if you suffer from asthma, bronchitis or allergies that affect breathing.
- Store in a cool, dry place.
- Keep out of the reach of children.

SUITABLE FABRICS

This product is suitable for cotton, linen and viscose fabrics only.

NOT suitable for polyester, polyester/cotton mixes, acrylic, nylon, wool, silk & special finishes (e.g. waterproof or dry clean only).
