

Dylon Satin Shoe Dye Instructions

Product Information

- Suitable for use on satin shoes only
- Do not use on silk shoes
- This product is a dye, and will NOT cover stains or dirt
- If shoes are already coloured, the colour will mix. Example – using red dye on blue shoes will give a purple result.
- One pack contains sufficient dye for one pair of average size shoes.

How to use

1. Clean shoes prior to dyeing to ensure they are free from stains. Dye will not cover up dirt.
2. Wearing rubber gloves, shake bottle and pour dye into an old saucer or small container.
3. Ensure brush is thoroughly wetted with dye before commencing.
4. Starting at the back seam, apply the dye with the brush working round to the front of the shoe and finishing at the back seam again.
5. Dye the heel. Do not saturate the shoe with dye.
6. Immediately after the first coat, lightly re-apply the dye to the whole shoe using circular brush strokes.
7. Whilst wet, the result may still appear patchy, but this will even out once dry.
8. Leave shoes to dry away from direct heat and sunlight.

Other types of shoe

This product is suitable for satin shoes only.

For normal shoes, please use Dylon Shoe Colour

For leather boots, please use Dylon Shoe Dye

For suede or nubuck, please use Dylon Suede & Nubuck Shoe Dye
