

Dylon Shoe Colour Instructions

Product Information

- Suitable for use on leather, imitation leather or canvas shoes
- Can also be used for leather bags, mobile phone cases and belts
- Will cover over other colours
- One pack will cover one pair of average size shoes.
- Colours can be intermixed to create additional shades
- NOT suitable for suede, nubuck or satin shoes.

How to use – leather or imitation leather

1. Clean surface to be coloured with a damp cloth.
2. Tightly pack shoes with newspaper to fill out the creases.
3. Dampen preparer pad with water and lightly rub abrasive side over entire surface to prepare it for colour. Wipe clean and allow to dry. The abrasive pad will scratch the surface but this will be covered by the shoe colour.
4. Shake bottle well. Apply a thin and even coat of colour with brush. Allow to dry.
5. Apply a second coat, washing brush between coats. Further coats may be necessary with some colours e.g. Gold and Silver.
6. Allow to dry overnight.

How to use – Canvas

1. Remove all grease marks with soapy water and allow to dry.
2. Do NOT use the abrasive side of the preparer pad.
3. Dilute shoe colour with 25% water or add water to shoulder of the plastic bottle and shake.
4. Apply as above.
5. Note - Some fabrics may stiffen as a result.

Other types of shoe

This product is suitable for changing the colour of leather and canvas only.

To restore colour to leather shoes or boots, please use Dylon Leather Shoe Dye

For suede or nubuck, please use Dylon Suede & Nubuck Shoe Dye.

For satin shoes, please use Dylon Satin Shoe Dye.
